HELEN C. WELSH, ASCCA, FACI, FPSA, FSAC, Albany, N.Y. U.S.A.

Helen Welsh has been active in amateur film clubs since 1942. She has taught motion picture photography, has lectured at colleges and international conventions, and has judged competitions both in U.S. and England. She writes articles for magazines, and reviews educational films for "Film News". Her films have won 22 international awards. She is the American Representative of the Institute of Amateur Cinematographers of Great Britain.

Helène Welsh a enseigné le cinéma et donné des conférences internationales et universitaires en cinématographie. Elle fut nommée à plusieurs reprises sur des jurys de Festivals Internationaux tant aux États-Unis qu'en Europe. Elle écrit des articles dans plusieurs revues spécialisées, et en particulier dans "Film News", et ses œuvres ont remporté plus de vingt prix internationaux. Elle est la Représentante en Amérique de l'Institut des Cinéastes Amateurs de Grande-Bretagne.

T.V. ADAMS, Ottawa, Ontario Canada

Vic Adams was a teacher and amateur film maker in British Columbia in the '30's. He joined the National Film Board in 1946 and was responsible for rural circuit programs and classroom productions. He became Director of International Distribution, Representative in Europe, and Chief, Sponsored Program Division. He retired in 1972 to organize the film school at Algonquin College. He formed Adams & Associates in 1974 as a post production studio and equipment supplier for the super 8 medium.

Vic Adams était professeur et cinéaste amateur en Colombie Britannique dans les années '30. En 1946 se joint à l'Office National du Film et devient responsable des projections rurales et des productions étudiantes. Pour la suite fut nommé Directeur de la Distribution Internationale, Représentant en Europe, et chef des programmes commandités. Retraite en 1972, il organisa le département cinématographique au Collège Algonquin. En 1974 il crea Adams et Associés, offrant les services de post production et de ventes pour le format super 8.

JAMES B. KELLY

James Kelly has taught courses in Film Theory, Production and History at the Ryerson Polytechnical Institute, Toronto, Canada, the Rochester Institute of Technology, U.S.A. and the Montana State University, U.S.A. He has supervised hundreds of student films that have won top prizes in international competitions. He has been Director of Photography of Dramatic Films such as "Outrageous", "Power Play", "The Newcomers", "Louis Riel", and many others. He has made several Documentaries and has been involved in many Commercials. His personal film "Dunmovin" has been widely screened and received international acclaim. James has been a guest of the Chinese Government and the Beijing Film Academy and toured China's major film studios in Beijing, Chengdu, Xian, and Shanghai.

James Kelly a Enseigné des Cours de Théorie, Production et Histoire de Film à l'Institut de Technologie Ryerson de Toronto (Canada), à l'Institut de Technologie de Rochester (États-Unis) et à l'Université de Montana (États-Unis). Il a surveillé des centaines de films d'étudiant qui ont gagné des prix majeurs en compétitions internationales. Il était Directeur de Photographie de films dramatiques tels que "Outrageous", "Power Play", "The Newcomers", et "Louis Riel" parmi beaucoup d'autres. Il a fait plusieurs documentaires et a participé dans la création de beaucoup d'annonces publicitaires. Son film personnel "Dunmovin" a été disséminé et acclame partout. James était un invité du Gouvernement Chinois et de l'Académie de Film de Beijing et a fait des tours des studios de films de Beijing, Chengdu, Xian et Shanghai.

ELVINO SAURO

Elvino Sauro obtained his Radio & Television Arts Diploma from Ryerson Institute of Technology in Toronto, Canada, where he currently is a Professor in the Film & Photography Department. He also holds a BA degree in Music from the University of Toronto, Canada, and a Master of Arts Degree from the University of Sussex, England. Elvino has been a Broadcast Operator (CFRB), a Television Producer (CJIC-TV), a Television Script Assistant (CBC-TV), a Film Sound Recordist-Editor-Mixer for Telesound Film Recordings, a Film Production Manager for Impact Telefilms in England, a Publicist, a Writer-Editor-Scheduler (CBC) and recently has been an Advisor on the curriculum and new facilities for the Beijing Film Academy in the Peoples Republic of China.

Elvino Sauro a obtenu son Diplôme des Arts de Radio et Télévision de l'Institut de Technologie de Ryerson à Toronto (Canada) où il est actuellement Professeur dans le Département de Film et Photographie. Il est aussi Diplômé en Musique de l'Université de Toronto (Canada) et il a sa Maîtrise en Lettres de l'Université de Sussex (Angleterre). Elvino a été Opérateur des Emissions (CFRB), Directeurs de Télévision (CJIC-TV), Assistant de Manuscrit de Télévision (CBC-TV), Editeur de Film pour "Telesound Film Recordings", Gérant de Production de film pour "Impact Telefilms" en Angleterre, Publiciste, Ecrivain, Editeur (CBC) et Récemment a été Conseiller de Curriculum et de Nouvelles Facilités pour l'Académie de Film de Beijing en Chine.

DAVID FARR, M.Ed., Hamilton Ontario

David Farr was very active in the amateur film scene for many years, and was the first winner of the Garlick Trophy. He attended film courses at the University of Southern California, and had the opportunity to shoot three films in Hollywood. Over the years he has taught film making at the University and College level, worked in distribution and, as head of a Film Department, has purchased hundreds of films. Dave started FARR FILMS INC., a film production company, about 20 years ago, and has recently expanded to international distribution, with outlets in Canada, U.S.A and Australia.
